The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

Dirck Brinckerhoff, Maria Van Aalstyn, h.v.v. Abraham Van Wyck, Junr., witnessed the baptism 15 Dec 1751 NYC Ref Ch, of Theodorus, son of Theodorus Van Wyck & Helena Santfort.

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Abraham Van Wyck, of New York, shopkeeper, being of sound mind. I leave to my son Abraham my pike and sword and £5 for his right as eldest son. My shop goods and other effects are to be sold and turned into money as soon as conveniently may be. My wife is to have such household furniture as she may wish at appraised value. "If my wife should not happen to be with child, then I leave her 1/2 of all my estate, and the other half to my son Abraham. But if my wife prove to be with child, then I give her £50, and the rest to my son Abraham and my other child." If my children should die, then I leave 1/2 to my wife and the other half to my father, Abraham Van Wyck, and my mother, Catharine Van Wyck. I make my wife and my brother, Theodorus Van Wyck, and my brother in law, Dirck Brinckerhoff, ex-ecutors. Dated February 24, 1756. Witnesses, Anthony Ten Eyck, Dirck Brinckerhoff, Joseph Marshall. Proved, May 14, 1756.

They settled in East Woods (now Syosset), where they built a house next west from the old homestead of John Hewlett, which later became the property of Stephen Robbins.

In his will, dated 21 Jan 1750, prob. 13 Feb., 1749/50, he wrote: I, Barent Van Wyck, of Oyster Bay, yeoman, being infirm, this January 21, 174 9/50. I leave all the houses and lands and improvements which I bought of Othniel Sands (next to Plain land), together with all houses and lands I bought of John Voorhees, and the house and land which I have at Manathill, with the Plain lot which I have joining to Manathill land, all to be sold by my executors. All debts to be paid, and I leave all the rest of the proceeds to my wife Hannah, and my three daughters, Mary, Sarah, and Abigail, when they are 18. I leave to my wife Hannah two of my best beds and bed furniture to them belonging. My executors are to retain so much personal property and stock as my wife and family may need so long as she remains my widow, and after her death or marriage, then to my four sons, Thomas, Theodorus, Samuel, and Abraham, all the houses and improvements where I now dwell, except what I have reserved to be sold. My wife is to dwell in my house and have her support while living. I make my son Thomas and my brother-in-law, Richard Thorne, and my friend, George Youngs, executors. Witnesses, Charles Peters, Johanes Van Cott, Samuel Willis. The bonds due to me are to go to pay debts before lands are sold. Proved, February 13, 1749.

The immigrant Cornelis Barents lived in Wijck bij Duurstede in Utrecht Province, the Netherlands. Cornelis Barentse Van Wyck emigrated to this country from Wyck, near Teck, Holland, in 1660, and settled in Flatlands, L. I.

In their joint will dated 17 June 1684, Cornelis Barents Van Wyck and Annatie his wife, named as guardians: Theodorus Polhemus and Koert Stevenson. Children not named. Witnesses: Adriaen Reyerse and Pieter Guilliamse. (Flatbush Town Records, Liber C, p. 169).

Cornelius was Surveyor of Queens Co., NY in 1727. In 1732 he moved from Long Island to Fishkill, Dutchess Co., NY. He was Justice of the Peace in 1743.

In his will, he wrote: ...November 24, 1757, I, Cornelius Van Wyck, of Rombout Precinct, in Duches County, being in full health. I direct all debts to be paid. I leave to my wife Hannah £42 yearly and the use of the west room in my house, and the adjacent little room, with all their furniture, "Also the use of my chair and chair horse, and chair house, and a negro wench of her own choice," while she remains my widow. "In case she shall marry, she shall have £20 yearly for life." "My will and pleasure is that the north part of my farm, adjoining the Fish kill, where my son Theodorus, deceased, formerly lived, being all that tract north of a line run by John Cuve, Beginning at the west of the Clove by the mountain, at a chestnut sapling, and running thence North 54 Degrees East 27 chains, 25 Links, to an Iron wood tree, Then N. 71 E. 25, 41, to a stake and a live fence, Then N. 4 E. along the fence and a ditch 9 chains, Thence along fence and ditch N. 36 W. 4 chains, Then N. 11 W. 5, 25, to the fork of a ditch, Then N. 46, 50 E. 17, 21, to a small apple tree on the east side of the Post road, and by the lime kiln field fence, Then N. 8, 30 W. 9, 63, along the fence to a corner of said field, Then as the fence stands N. 81 E. 16, 26, to two wild cherry trees, Then N. 56 E. along a range of marked trees 90, 12, to two walnut saplings, Then N. 43, E. to my line at the foot of the mountain." Now all the land east of the last mentioned line, running along the lines of my farm, as they run to the Fish kill, and then along the Fish kill as it runs, and the bounds of my farm as it adjoins the plantation of my son Theodorus, deceased. Captain Ter Boss' land and the mountains to the place of beginning to be sold by my executors. And from the proceeds I leave to Sarah, the eldest daughter of my son Theodorus, £150 when of age or married, and to his son Cornelius £170 when of age. To his son Abraham £20 when of age. And the rest to all the children of my said son, Theodorus Van Wyck, deceased, viz., Sarah, Cornelius, Abraham, and Antye. And the said children are to pay to my wife £7 yearly. I leave to my son Richard, besides what I have already given him, 1/2 of my right in the Store House called Frankfort store and the land. I leave to my son Cornelius besides 1/2 the farm which remains after my son Theodorus' farm is taken off, which 1/2 I have given him by deed. I also give him my other half of Frankfort store and the land adjoining. I leave to my daughters Phebe, wife of George Adriance, Margaret, wife of Francis Brett, and Catharine, wife of Johanes Ter Boss, Jr., to each of them so much money out of my movable estate as will, when added to the value of what furniture and effects I have given to each since their marriage, amount to £450 each. And each of them shall pay to my wife £7 yearly. And if she remarries, they shall pay her 1/6 of £20 yearly. My executors are to sell the remaining half of the farm whereon I live, and the house, reserving my wife's right, to my son Cornelius at £750, and pay the money to my children as follows, To my daughter Phebe £125, To the children of my son Theodorus £125, "This is to be paid at the time when my son Theodorus, had he lived, would have been of the same age as my daughter Phebe was when she received her part," To my daughter Margaret £125, To my son Richard £125, And my son Cornelius shall allow himself £125, To my daughter Catharine £125. My executors may sell my negro man to my son Cornelius for £60. My other lands in the Lower Nine Partners Patent to be sold. My share of the disputed lands is left to such of my heirs as may try to retain them and pay the expenses of the same. I make my sons Richard and Cornelius and my son-in-law, Francis Brett, executors. Witnesses, Johanes Ter Boss, Theodorus Van Wyck, John Brinkerhoff. Proved, May 21, 1763, before Jacobus Ter Boss, First Judge of Common Pleas, and James Duncan and Cornelius Leyster, Justices. The witness Johanes Ter Boss was then dead. [NOTE.--The farm so accurately described, is situated in the Town of Fishkill, on the north side of the mountains, and bounded south by them--W. S. P.]

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Cornelius Van Wyck, of Flushing, in Queens County, being in perfect health. I leave to my daughter Phebe £250, and to my daughter Catharine £250; To my daughters, Phebe and Catharine, each a good bed; To my daughter Mary £150. I leave to my wife Mary £20 a year, to be paid by my three sons, Stephen, Cornelius, and Gilbert. I leave to my wife and my daughters, Phebe and Catharine, the use of one room. In his will, he wrote: February 8, 1728. I, Johanes Van Wyck, of the town of Flushing, in Queens County, Esq., "being by God's blessing in bodily health." I leave to my true and loving wife, Phebe, the use and income of my whole estate, during her widowhood, or until my son William shall be of age. If she remarry, I give her £300 for her dower; I also give her a negro girl "Isabel," 2 cows, a riding horse, a side saddle, and a feather bed and furniture, and the use of one of the rooms in my dwelling house, and the pasturing and wintering of two cows and a horse. I leave to my son Cornelius, £50. I leave to my son William all that part of my home farm I now live on, viz., that is from my southwest corner of a 20 acre lot lately mine, and now in possession of William Hicks, and running from thence to the northeast corner of the land of my son Cornelius, with all the

houses and buildings and orchards. I also leave to my son William my wagons and gear and plows and plow tackling. In his will, he wrote: I, William Van Wyck, of ye City of New York, Distiller, being but weak in Body but of perfect understanding and memory blessed be ye Almighty for it. In order to pay my debts and funeral charges I give my executors full authority to sell all my estate except what I particularly give away. I give to my son William my silver tankard, to my daughter, Mary Van Wyck, £130 and my silver spoons, a Bed and Bedding sufficient for a Bed and a Bedstead, a half duzen of my chairs and a looking glass. The remaining part of my estate to be put out at interest and the interest yearly to my dearly beloved wife, Martha Van Wyck, during her life, and after her decease to my grandsons, Walter Burling, son of Thomas Burling, William Van Wyck Field, son of William Field, and Charles Burling, son of Edward Burling, to each £40; ye remaining part to my six children: my daughters Deborah, wife of Edward Burling, Phebe, wife of Thomas Burling, Hannah, wife of William Field, Abbigal, wife of Charles Arding, and my son, William Van Wyck, and my daughter, Mary Van Wyck, equally divided. If any unforeseen accident should happen that ye estate should come to less by being put out at interest my will is that my executors be no losers thereby. I appoint my sons-in-law, William Field, and Charles Arding, my executors. Dated this 7th day of 6th month, 1773. Witnesses, James Bowne, Richard Penny, of New York City, Barber; Peter Field. Proved, New York, April 5, 1785. Administration granted to Charles Arding the same day.
