The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

Adam Wensel Van Zandt, the progenitor of one branch of the Van Zandt family in America, came from Arnheim in Gelderland, Netherlands. He emigrated from Netherlands on [Vergulden Meulen (The Golden Mill) leaving June 7, 1658¹, with his wife and two children. His name is given on the record as "Adam Van Santen." He died almost immediately after arriving at New Amsterdam—indeed perhaps on the voyage over. His widow, Jannetje Jans, must have united with the Dutch Church at New Amsterdam upon her arrival here, as her name, "Janneken Jans, Wede van Adam Wentszen," appears on a list of the members of the church between 1649 and 1660.

Wednesday 19 March 1659. Janneke Jans coming before the Board reports, that intending to marry again, becoming the wife of Isaac Abrahamsen, she desires to settle upon her children their paternal estates and produces the inventory thereof, made by her late husband. The Board appoints Egbert Woutersen and Gerrit the miller, as guardians. "Whereas Jenneke Jans, widow of Adam Wensels, intends to marry again and become the wife of Isaac Abrahamsen, bachellor, and whereas she has at present two living children by said Adam Wensels, upon whom she intends to settle their father's property...." (The Minutes of the Orphanmasters of New Amsterdam 1655-1663 by Berthold Fernow. [OM:81,82])

Wednesday 19 March 1659. Jenneken Jans announces her intended marriage to Isaack Abrahamsen. Egbert Wouters and Gerrit Moolenaar have been appointed guardians of her two children. Her deceased husband was Adam Wensels. (Orphan Master records [HSYB 1900:116])

Stoffel Van Sant left New Utrecht before the 1698 census was taken, and moved across the narrows to Staten Island. On 22 May 1699 as Christopher Garretson of Staten Island, husbandman, he purchased from Josiah Marlet and Jane his wife 78 acres on the south side of the island at the New Dorp for £120. Stoffel Garrison Van Sant and Rachael his wife of Staten Island sold this 78 acres and another 78 acres (which he had purchased 5 March 1702, but for which the deed was not recorded) on 2 May 1706 to Aries Janson for £300. Stoffel had settled in Bucks County, PA by 23 May 1706 when he purchased 300 acres of land in Middletown from Henry Paulus.¹

Stoffel and his wife were original members of the "Sammeney" (named after the local Neschaminy Creek) Dutch Reformed Church at Bensalem, Bucks County, where he was Senior Deacon in 1710 and Elder in 1730. Stoffel was a Justice of the Peace for Bucks County 1715-1727 and was elected to the Pennsylvania Colonial Assembly in 1710, 1712, 1714 and 1719.¹

Stoffel Vansand made his will in Middletown [PA] 24 June 1749, probated 21 Aug 1749. He mentioned son John; son James and his children; daus. Sina, Rachel, and Olshe Rue; children of daughter Elizabeth; and grandson William Renberry. No wife was mentioned. Executors were his son John and his son-in-law Lewis Rue.¹

Garrett came to New Amsterdam in 1651, settling in the Brooklyn area. Elizabeth came to America at age 9, with her mother, Josyntje Verhagen (widow of Cornelis Van Westen & Thomas Thomaszen) in Feb 1659 on *The Faith*.

Garrett married Elizabeth and had eleven children. In the 1690s he and several of his sons began purchasing large amounts of land in Bucks County, PA. Since Garrett and his entire family moved to Bucks County about 1695, this group became known as the Bucks County line.¹

My executors are to sell all my estate, except my best bed and bedstead and furniture, and my great silver cup, my silver mugg and silver spoon and fork; all of which I give to my wife Margaret. I also leave her £25 a year. I leave to my eldest son Wygant 20s. for his birthright. To my son Isaac one negro, and £25. To my son Bernardus one negro. Such of my daughters as have not had a gold chain are to have one. Mentions "rest of my sons and daughters" (not named). I make my son Wygant, executor. Witnesses, B. Furman, Richard Alsop, N. De Meyer. Proved, November 9, 1724.

Wynant Van Zandt became very wealthy. In his will he calls himself a "blockmaker." His home was in William Street, and many pieces of elaborately wrought silver and a carved chair of state are preserved from the home.

In his will, Wynant wrote: In the name of God, Amen. I, Wynant Van Zant, of New York, blockmaker, being in good health. I leave to my wife Catharine all my personal effects and the use of all real estate during her life. After her death, my executors are to sell all estate. I leave to my eldest son John £5, in full bar to any claims. I leave to my grand son, Peter Praa Van Zandt, son of my son John, £50. I leave to my grand son, Wynant Van Zandt, son of Peter Praa Van Zandt, £10. To my grand son Johannes, son of my son, Peter Praa Van Zandt, £10. I leave to my grand son Abraham, son of Peter Praa Van Zandt, £10. To my grand daughter Catharine, daughter of my son, Peter Praa Van Zandt, £10, to be paid to each when 21. All the rest of the money from sales of land I leave to my daughter Catharine, wife of Thomas Witter, and to my daughter Johana, wife of Austin Lawrence, and to my sons, Jacobus, Wynant, and Tobias Van Zandt. During the Revolution he apparently changed his given name from Wynant to Viner, probably a corruption of Wynant. Wynant Van Zandt and John Fell were kidnapped by the Tories in Bergen Co. and imprisoned in NYC.

Viner Van Zandt, Jr. was proposed for membership in the American Union Lodge on 18 July 1776, and was made an Entered apprentice on 25 July. He was present at the meeting in NYC on 15 Aug 1776, held just before the battle of Long Island. (The American Union Lodge was a Lodge of Masons formed in MA during the siege of Boston. It met there, and in NYC, and up the Hudson until 1783. It contained a striking collection of American great men.) He was made a member of Solomon's Lodgem No. 1, at Poughkeepsie on 23 Feb 1777, only a few months before his capture by Tories in Bergen Co., NJ.

After the Revolution he became an auctioneer at 202 Water St., and is listed in the first directory of NYC in 1786
He never married.
