The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolution of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

In his will, he wrote: ...December 9, 1754. I, Aert Vanderbilt, of Flatbush, being sick and weak, but of perfect mind. All lawful debts and funeral charges to be paid out of my estate. It is my will and order that my beloved wife Sytie shall have all the income and profit of all my real and personal estate during her widowhood, to maintain and give an outset to my unmarried children. "But in case it shall happen that my wife should dye before the outsets of my unmarried children are completed, then, in such case, each of my unmarried children shall have for an outset the sum of £40, to be paid out of my estate before any division is made." I leave to my son, Aert Vanderbilt, £5, and likewise my Great Dutch Bible for his birth right, as my eldest son and heir. My executors may sell land to pay debts. If it shall happen that after the death or marriage of my wife my children cannot agree that any of my children shall have my real estate, then my executors may sell all the real and personal estate to the best advantage, and divide the money among my children, viz., Antye, wife of Leffert Leffertse, Hillitie, wife of Leffert Martense, Marytie, wife of Abraham Croogaert, Lammetje Vanderbilt, Sytie, wife of Dowe Van Duyn, Jannetie Vanderbilt, Aert Vanderbilt, and Peter Vanderbilt. I make Peter Stryker, Jeremias Vanderbilt, and Leffert Martense, executors. Witnesses, Philip Nagel, Jr., Joris Martense, Joseph Fonck. Proved, May 17, 1762.

In the NYC Ref Ch (1) marriage record, they were: Jan Arentsz van der Bilt, j.m. en Anneken Hendricks, j.d. Van Bergen in Noorwegen.

George Olin Zabriskie speculated that Annatje Hendricks may have been the sister of Belitje Hendricks who m. Cornelis Aertszen [Van Schaick], and also sister of Geertje Hendricks, who m. Andries Willemsz Hopper.² Others, including Pam Sears and Harry Macy believe that these three women were not related.

In the (3) Bergen Ref Ch record of their banns, they were: Jan Aertszen Vande Bilt (widower) and Madeleentje Hanse (widow); received certificate to Breuckelen on Dec. 10. Their banns were also recorded at Flatbush Ref Ch: Upon certificate from Bergen, there betrothed, the 7th November, Jan Arisz vander Bild, widower of Dierber Cornelis, residing in Midwood, with Magdaleentje Hanssen, widow of Harman Euduardsz, residing at Bergen; with certificate from there married the 11 December at Brooklyn.

Jan, son of Aert, from "the Bilt," a village in the province of Utrecht, came to this country as early as or before 1650 and settled at Flatbush and later Bergen. In the Flatbush records, The member list, "Old Members found here in the 4 villiages in the year 1677" shows under Midwoud [Flatbush]: "Jan vander Bild" next to his entry it says he left for Bergen.

On 13 Nov 1681 the banns were announced in Bergen, NJ, for "Jan Aertszen Vande Bilt (widower) and Maddeleentje Janse (widow)." They "Received certificate to Breucklen on Dec. 10" In the (2) marriage record, they were: "Jan Arisz vander Bild, widower of Dierber Cornelis, residing in Midwood" and "Magdaleentje Hanssen, widow of Harman Euduardsz, residing at Bergen."

On 16 April 1694, Magdalena Hans Vander Bilt, widow of Hendrick Janson Spear and with the consent of her husband Jan Arontson Vander Bilt, of Bergen County, at a place called Mingague Harness, conveyed to Garret Ivers Garretson, of the same place, land of former husband, adjoining Bertole Claesen. Witnessed by Jan Aronlson Vander Bilt, Hendrick Van Spear (his mark), Hans Hendrich Spear (his mark), Barent Hendrick Spear (his mark), Brefant Androsen Lovers, Gilbert Bogart, William Douglas, and David Provoost.¹

In the Flatbush Ref Ch record of their banns, they were: Jan van der Bilt, young man, born and residing at Jamaica, and Getruit Hardenbergh, young lady, born and residing at Jamaica.

In his will, he wrote: April 30, 1761. I, John Vanderbilt, of Hempstead, in Queens County, being of perfect mind. I leave to my son John £20 and the wagon he now has. I also give to my son John all the farm he now lives on, and he is to pay to my four sons, Jacob, Geritt, William, and Hendrick, £235, in six payments, in six years. And whereas I have bonds against my son Dirck to the amount of £365, If he pays the amount of £335 to my said sons, then the bonds to be cancelled. I leave to the daughter of my wife, Margaret Van Noorstrand, 1/4 of the money that my father-in-law, William Hoogland, left me, provided she remains satisfied with the division of her father's estate. I leave to my granddaughter, Antie Van Noorstrand, a cupboard. I leave to my wife Margaret the use of my farm and all my movables, so long as she remains my widow. "If she marries, I give her the household goods which was hers when I married her." After the death of my wife, all my lands and movable estate shall be sold. From the proceeds, I leave to my sons, Jacob, Dirck, Gerritt, William, Hendrick, and John, each £20. Of the rest, I leave 1/9 to the 5 children of my daughter Mary, deceased, and all the rest to my sons and my daughters, Margaret Dodge and Geertruy Remsen. I make my sons John and Geritt, and my two nephews, Hendricus and Petrus Onderdonk, ex-ecutors. Witnesses, Joris Rapelye, Andries Hegeman, Sr., Elbert Hegeman, Jr. Proved, April 30, 1768.²

He lived in the precinct of Haverstraw in what later became Clarkstown. He was a merchant and accumulated considerable real estate. He was a Revolutionary War veteran, serving in the 2nd Regt., Orange County, NY Militia.

In the printed Clarkstown baptisms (Clarkstown bp. #1631 in Cole's *History of Rockland County*), Cole adds a footnote to the 23 Dec 1781 baptism: "To this name, Jannetje Vanderbilt, I find a note in pencil, in handwriting I recognize as my father's, as follows: "Died Aug. 6/70—88 yrs., 7 mos., 28 days." The "Annatje Van Houten:" of this No. 1631 [wife of Johannes Vanderbilt] was sister of Catharine [Tryntjemet] Van Houten, my father's mother's mother."
