He was a member of the Burgher Militia Corps of New Amsterdam in 1653. In that year he bought and sold a lot on Broadway in New Amsterdam. Sometime between 1653 and 1655 he returned to Holland and married there, returning later to America. In July 1658 he was mentioned as a tailor, and in June 1658 he received a permit to employ Indians as brokers for the purchase of furs. In Jan 1660 he owned a lot in Albany, and seems to have speculated considerably in Albany real estate.¹

1746-7, Feb. 2. Inventory of the estate (£261.18) includes things belonging to the clockmaking or watchmaker's trade, 2 gold rings, old gold and old silver. Made by Jacob Sutvin, William Ker, John Henderson.
