The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

He may have built, about 1830, the sandstone "Adam Vandelinda House" at what is today 586 Teaneck Road, Teaneck, Bergen Co., NJ. The house was built on land that was part of the Kiersted Patent of 1686.

Adam Vandalinda, 65, farmer, and Nancy Vandalinda, 62, were listed in the 1850 Federal Census, living in Hackensack Township. Living with them were: Peter Vandalinda, 49, laborer; John Leonard, 20, laborer (b. Ireland); and Margaret Phelan, 17 (b. Ireland). Listed immediately after this household was the family of John A. Vandalinda, [wife] Jane, and son, Adam, 11.

He was listed in the 1860 Federal Census, New Jersey, Bergen Co., Hackensack Township, p. 43-44, enumerated 3 July 1860, Dwelling 281, Family 297 (all b. NJ, except as noted) -- Adam Vandelinda, 75, Farmer, value real estate \$10,000, value personal estate \$2000; John [Vandelinda], 46, Fasmmer; Jane [Vandelinda], 42, Wife; Jane Brinkerhoff, 78, Widow; Kate Nockton, 25, Servant, b. Ireland; Peter Vandelinda, 62, Agent; Cosia A. Christie, 8.

Benjamin Vanderlinde was Pastor of the Reformed Church of Paramus from 1748 until his death in 1789. In addition, he served as pastor of the Ponds Church (Oakland) from 1748-1788, pastor of the Saddle River Reformed Church (1784-1789, shared with Paramus) and pastor of the Ramapo Reformed Church (now Mahwah) from 1785-?.

On 30 June 1760, Hendrick vander Linde, of New Barbadoes Precinct, Bergen County, NJ [conveyed] to Roelif vander Linde, Dominie Benjamin vander Linde, of Bergen County, NJ and Samuel ver Bruyck (Dominie ver Bruyck in remainder of deed), of Tappan, Orange Co., NY, for £400, part of the Samuel Bayard Patent. Signed Hendrick vander Linde. Wit: Isack Huysman, Roelif Westervelt, and John Coe, of Orange Co., NY.<sup>1</sup>

Benjamin Vanderlinde built a frame house on Chestnut Ridge Road (north of today's Upper Saddle River) which still stands, about half a mile north of the present state line.

Hendrick Vanderlinda lived at Polifly, below Hackensack, Bergen Co., NJ.

Hendrick received, through his father's will, lands on the Pascack and Saddle Rivers.

Hendrick Vandelinde bought most of the Bayard Patent lands (in today's Upper Saddle River, Montvale, Woodcliff Lake) before 4 May 1737 (the date on which he first sold a part). These lands were then considered to be in Orange County, NY, but this assignation was long contested by the East Jersey Proprietors, who considered the land to be in New Jersey. By the time the Clinton survey was made in 1738-39 (for the NY Cheesecocks patent to the north, which erroneously overlapped the later established NY-NJ boundary), Vanderlinda had already established tenants at various locations and had sold land to Arie King, upon which King had by that time a house and improvements near the Pascack Brook, south of present Grand Avenue.<sup>2</sup>

On 2 Apr 1731, John alias Hans Spear, yeoman, of Newark, Essex Co., NJ (attorney for Peter Sonmans of Perth Amboy, Middlesex Co., NJ) [conveyed] to Henry vander Linde, yeomans, of Hackensack, Bergen County, NJ, [for] £80, 205 acres ... corner to John van Orden ... line of Abraham Le Roux and Jacob Zabriskie ... corner to John Bogart, John Bernard van Dussen and John Durie. Signed Hans (x) Spear.<sup>1</sup>

In 1759 Hendrick Vanderlinda and his wife gave deeds to their children for certain subdivisions of the Bayard Patent (west of the Kakiat Patent in Bergen County, NJ).<sup>2</sup>

On 30 June 1760, Hendrick vander Linde, of New Barbadoes Precinct, Bergen County, NJ [conveyed] to Roelif vander Linde, Dominie Benjamin vander Linde, of Bergen County, NJ and Samuel ver Bruyck (Dominie ver Bruyck in remainder of deed), of Tappan, Orange Co., NY, for £400, part of the Samuel Bayard Patent. Signed Hendrick vander Linde. Wit: Isack Huysman, Roelif Westervelt, and John Coe, of Orange Co., NY.<sup>1</sup>

These 1759 and 1760 transfers were apparently made in lieu of a Will and ended Hendrick's ownership of these tracts. He died subsequent to this time leaving no recorded estate.

Jan Quisthout was charged with, and found guilty of, sodomy on his servant, a young orphan lad from Amsterdam named Hendrick Harmensen. Jan, a soldier was sentenced to be executed, and he was on 17 June 1660 "taken to the place of execution and there stripped of his arms, his sword broken at his feet and he then tied in a sack and cast into the river and drowned until dead" His servant, who by the courts own admission was forced by Quisthout to commit this crime, was whipped and 'sent elsewhere' [Source: Council Minutes Vol. IX 1660 in Dutch Manuscripts in Calendar of Historical Manuscripts in the Office of the Secretary of State, Albany NY edited by EB O'Callaghn. publ. 1865]

His widow, Jannetje, apparently returned to the Netherlands after the execution of her husband, for she can be found on the passenger list of The Golden Eagle (1661) as "Jannetje Barents; widow of Jan Quisthout." She must have returned to New Amsterdam, where she married a second time. On 16 Aug 1663 the council minutes show "Janneken Barents, widow of Jan van der Linden, praying for a writ empowering her to surrender all claim to her late husband's estate in favour of his creditors and to be discharged from such liabilities"

Pieter Van der Linde signed an agreement on 19 April 1639 with David Pietersen de Vries and Frederic de Vries, partners, for his passage to New Netherland and his release from their service, and gave them a note dated the day previous for 140 carolus guilders to pay the passage of himself and unnamed wife on the ship *Love*.

Roelof, with others, obtained 4 Sep 1674 of Gov. Colve a deed for 264 acres of land on the Northwest Hoek of Staten Island. Roelof Van der Linde and his wife, Susanna Hendriks were members of the Hackensack Church in 1686.

In the (1) marriage record they are: "Roelof Vanderlinde, Y.M., from Wageningen in Gelderland and Susanna Hendricks Bronckhorst [Brinkerhoff], Y.D., from Midwout on Long Island."

On 19 March 1717, Jurie and Fraina Morris, brewer, of Hackensack, conveyed to Carrol Debane, yeoman, of the same place, for £100, 113 acres, patented 17 Aug 1686 by Gawin Lowry, and his heirs Mille and Rebecca Forster, Mary Haigs and Obadiah Haigs sold to **Rouluf Vander Linde** on 10 Aug 1696, who in his will gave to his son **Hendrick Vander Linda** who sold to said Morris, Johannis Hartwick and John Van Schiven; in Hackensack Township; corner to John Van Schiven. Signed Juris Morris (his mark), Fraina Morris (her mark). Witnessed by David Demarest, Robert Livesey, Thomas Van Boskerk.<sup>2</sup>

In his will, dated 6 Sep 1709, probated 13 Feb 1709/10, he wrote: "...I, Rudolphus Van der Linde, of Hackensack, in the County of Bergen, in New Jersey, yeoman. I make my brother-in-law, Andrew Van Buskirk, of Mingachsquai, and Cornelius Blinkerhoff, of Comunipaw, my executors. My wife Rachel is to have a free living and habitation on my farm or Plantation where I at present live, and £25 in money, and firewood and pasture for a cow. I leave to my two daughters, Claarje and Margaretie, each an equal portion when married. I leave all my real estate, houses, and lands to my two sons, Peter and Henry. My eldest son Peter shall have the choice of my two plantations or farms, either the one where I live at present, or the plantation or farm called Tappan, and my son Henry shall have the other. I appraise my dwelling house and plantation where I now live at £300, and the Plantation or farm at Tappan, at £100. And they are to pay to my daughters Vechtie, Claarje, Geesye, and Marytie, one-sixth of the appraised value. My son Peter is to have my gun as an allowance for his birthright. Witnesses, William Barent, Simon Brestie, John Conrad Codwin. Proved, February 13, 1709/10.
