The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

Aernout Viele was taken captive by the French and their "christianized" Indian allies and lived amongst the Canadian Indian tribes for several years. He became a renowned Indian interpreter upon his return to the Dutch Colony.

He lived at Ft. Orange, Peekskill, and Beverwyck, where he was a fur trader and operated a tavern/trading post.

Aerhnout was in Albany by 1659 and last heard of in Dutches Co 1704. Gerritje was "from Amsterdam before 1667.

She arrived in New Netherland about 1624 with her parents.

Maria apparently also had an illegitimate daughter, Aletje Pieters Van Couvenhoven, fathered by Pieter Wolfertszen Van Couvenhoven. She may also have had another child, fathered by Pieter.

Cornelis Volckertszen was from Knipphausen, near Wilhelmshaven, in Oldenburg, Germany.

Cornelis Volckertszen Viele was a trader and tavern-keeper of New Amsterdam in 1639; probably a sailmaker and trader of Hoorn. A document dated June 5, 1614 states that Cornelis Volkertszen, Bookseller resided at Hoorn on the Nieuwland (street) in the house called "t Vergulde Claver" (the golden clover). He was an investor in the ship "The Fortuyn" which explored the Hudson River in 1613 just four years after Henry Hudson (1609). He was also an investor in the New Netherland Company formed to explore and settle New Amsterdam. He evidently followed his investment by settling in New York.

According to Minutes of the Amsterdam Chamber of the Dutch West India Company, on 18 Feb 1636 Cornelis Volckertszen requests payment of the wages earned by Phillipe de Truiex, according to the certificate of the Council and the power of attorney executed in New Netherland. Referred to the Commissioners of New Netherland.¹

Maria Du Trieux m. (2) **Jan Peek**.

In 1663, Maria and her second husband, Jan were banished from New York for selling alcohol on the Sabbath and also to the Indians. She lived with her son Jacobus in Schenectady in her later years. Her husband, Jan was an Innkeeper in New Amsterdam and had a trading post up the Hudson River at "Jan Peek's Kill". In 1655 he sold two houses at Fort Orange to Johannes Dyckman for 1627 guilders.

Cornelis Corneliszen Viele grew up with an understanding of the Indian -- his ways, his language and his manner of trading -- which fitted him to be an interpreter, as was his brother, Aernout, a friend of the Red man, and also, no doubt, somewhat of a trader in his tavern in Schenectady. There is record of his acting as interpreter and of his refusing to so ace. There is a record of a gift to him from the Indians, which vouches for their friendly feeling, and doubtless, their sense of obligation, for the Indians never forgot a friend any more than they did an enemy. His license as a tavern keeper in Schenectady was granted him in 1672 as a special favor from the Albany authorities for services rendered to them, so that while he may not have been as brilliant as his brother, Aernout, He held for many years the outposts of civilization in New York State. It has been reported that a party was being held at his tavern the night of a bloody Indian massacre. He probably survived since his name is on the list of survivors to receive assistance, but he undoubtedly died shortly thereafter, perhaps from his wounds. After 1690 he is no longer mentioned in the records and his tavern was taken over by Douve Aukes who also adopted his son, Cornelis Jr. Aukes may have married Suster (Cornelis C Viele's Widow) after his death. The name "Suster" was perpetuated in the family for 150 years since each descendant had named a child, Suster. The name is not found in any other record of early Dutch Families in New York.

In the Schenectady Ref Ch record of their marriage they were a j.m. and a j.d., both of Schenectady.

This Cornelius was the adopted son of Douw Aukes [DeFreest] and to whom Douw Aukes conveyed (when Douw Aukes was 80 years of age), all his lands in Schenectady. Some of this was land that had been taken up by Cornelis, Sr., and had somehow come into Aukes' possession.

In 1720 Cornelis Feele is on the list of freeholders of Schenectady. 1733, Nov. 3, Cornelis Feeling took out Letters of administration of the estate of Doww Aakis who died intestate. (His. Soc. Absts. of Wills, Vol III, p. 126.)

On Jan. 11, 1699, Louwis Viele took the oath at Schenectady.

In 1708, being about to remove to Schaghticoke Louwis Viele conveyed to the Trustees of Schenectady land deeded to him by his mother, Jacomintje Swart in 1699, when she removed to Ulster Co. In Oct 1709 the City of Albany conveyed the land at Schaghticoke, N. Y., to the following persons who settled there at that time:--Johannes de Wandalaer, Jr., Johannes Harmans Vischer, Corset Vedder, Daniel Kettlehuyn, Johannes Harmensen Knickerbocker, Derick van Vechten, and Louwis Viele.

Louwis Viele was a man of considerable wealth for those days, and his Viele's Bridge toll was in operation for more than a century at Schaghticoke.

In his will, he wrote: March 24, 1759. I, Philip Vielle, of Kingston, in Ulster County, being weak in body. I leave to my grandson, Cornelius P. Vielle, son of my son Petrus, a large Dutch Bible, which is in the possession of his mother, Elizabeth Vielle, for his birth right, "being in lieu of anything he might claim as his birth right."
