The family groups represented in this collection may not be complete, because information was entered bit by bit as I found it or happened upon it; I have not done any systematic research on these families. Because they do not compose whole family genealogies, these listings are arranged differently from most genealogical records or histories. Each listing is a family group, and is arranged and filed alphabetically under the name of the head of the family.

Names are generally in alphabetical order (disregarding spelling variations and middle names), then in approx. chronological order. The first sorting is by surname (mixing together any and all spelling variations), then by given name, then by approximate birthdate (when known) in approximate chronological order. For easier reference, surnames in headings are grouped together under the most common spelling usage that evolved in this geographical location, regardless of individualistic spellings in the records themselves. Cross references are used in most cases where surname spellings substantially vary.

Within the quoted records, the individual spellings have been (mostly) retained because they sometimes provide clues (although in general—but with exceptions—they seem to largely reflect the record keeper's particular orthography and not always, at this early period, any special family preference). Those interested can see the variety and evolvement of a particular name's spelling and the interesting and sometimes amusing attempts at phonetic reproduction. Keep in mind that before names and spellings were standardized, records reflected the individualistic whim of the particular recorder (often two different spellings of the same name within the same document). In addition, all records were handwritten, and sometimes deciphering a handwritten name in early records can be quite challenging! So expect to search under all possibilities of spelling (for both surnames and given names).

Given names are grouped together without regard for middle initials or middle names. Because middle names and/or initials are sometimes used, sometimes not used in various records, it seemed simplest to arrange entries as if the middle names or initials did not exist. Usually all variations of a given name are grouped together as though spelled one way: Jan, Johannes, John, etc. are all grouped as one (but also look under the other forms).

Sources and references are included with each "family" grouping, but may or may not include sources that are cited (or are obvious, such as baptismal records, etc.) within the narrative or listing itself.

As with any compiled genealogical record, researchers should regard this information as leads and clues, and should verify all data with independent research.

I welcome, and would be grateful for, any additions or corrections, especially with source citations.

They summered at Saddle River in the 1880s and 1890s. They lived at 223 West Saddle River Road, Saddle River, Bergen County, NJ.

Their Saddle River estate included a large barn, boat house, and garage. Later, from 1919-1941 the property was rented by the YWCA in New York City and used as Camp Shadyside, a vacation resort for women. The barn was converted into a dormitory accommodating about 80 women, tennis courts were added, and the river was dammed to provide a better swimming area.

Evert Jansen Wendell came to New Amsterdam about 1642 (or about 1640 in the service of the Dutch West India Company<sup>1</sup>).

On 8 Feb 1647 he obtained a patent for a lot in what was then called the "Graft" (now Beaver Street), in New Amsterdam, but on or about the year 1651 he moved to Fort Orange (now Albany), where he was a ruling elder of the Dutch church in 1656, orphan master in 1657, and magistrate in 1660 and 1661. His lot in Albany was on the west corner of James and State Streets, which after his death was owned by his son, Thomas.

His will, dated 30 June 1663, mentioned late wife Susanna de Truwe, and mentioned children Elsie, aged 16; Johannes, 14; Diewer, 10; Jeronimus, 8; Philip, 5; and Evert, 3.<sup>1</sup>

In his will, he wrote: ...I, Evert Wendell, of the city of Albany, Attorney at Law. I leave to my oldest son Johanes all my surveying instruments, as Compass, etc.. Also my Law Books, in bar of all claims as heir at law and eldest son, and I do hereby exclude him from all my real and personal estate, "And I quit cut him out of all, nothing excepted I have in this world, and my reasons are to me best known." "However, I give and bequeath to his dear, pretty children, and the heirs of his body, all my real estate in the Town of Schenectady, as house, lands, pastures, gardens, and lots." "I give to my dear, trusty, faithful, beloved, honest son, Abraham Wendell, all my lands and premises in Albany, on both sides of the kill or creek, called the Beaver Creek, or Kill, as by several deeds made over to me, Together with the stream of water, and all buildings, saw mills, grist mills, brew house, etc., and all my carpenter and joiners' tools, log sledge and log chains, and all that belongs to my saw mills," "Also my Large Holland Gun, marked with my name on the lock," Also two lots of ground in the south part of the city, being Lots 10 and 5, as by deeds from the children and heirs of my father, Jeronimus Wendell may appear, Also another lot of ground in the north part of the city, next to the Pasture ground of Jesse De Vrest, "and have been allways used for a Term pitches or Yards," as by the deeds of the heirs of my father may appear. "Dear son Abraham, my will is that you dispose of the said three lots, and the money shall go towards paying my just debts, or you may keep them yourself, and pay the value to my creditors." It is my will that the farm or tract of land at the Normans Kill, which Killian Van Rensselaer and his wife Elizabeth have given to me, I give it to my son Abraham, "and humbly desire the Lord of the manor to confirm his ancestor's gift and give you an ample title," "And you shall let your brother Philip have two acres, he paying the tenth of the produce, according to the custom of the manor of Rensselaerwyck." I leave to my dear youngest son, Philip Wendell, all that my dwelling house and lot of ground in the first Ward of Albany, as made over to me by several deeds, and also my pasture land on both sides of the kill or creek, called the Rutters Kill, adjoining to my lot, as the same was made over to me by my father in law, Jan Lansingh, by his deed. But my son Philip shall not sell the same while my wife is living and his two sisters Elizabeth and Engeltie remain unmarried, But they shall remain and dwell in the said house, except as they may agree in writing. My son Philip shall have pasture for a horse in my pasture and free grinding for his bread corn, And my sons Abraham and Philip shall build a Chocolate mill for the use of my son Philip. I also leave to my son Philip my wearing apparel and a gun. I leave to my three daughters, Ariantie, Elizabeth, and Engeltie, "all my lot of pasture ground in the south part of the city, just behind the city Stockadoes." Which lot I purchased from my brothers Dirck and Daniel Brett, as by their deeds. I leave to my son Philip my large Clock, which I will shall remain in my dwelling house. I leave to my son Abraham all my negroes after my wife's decease. All the rest of my estate I leave to my 5 children, Abraham, Ariantie, Elizabeth, Engeltie, and Philip, and I make my son Abraham and my daughter Engeltie executors. Dated July 29, 1749. Francis Livingston Wandell practiced law in New York City with his brother Townsend Wandell. In 1901 his office was at 51 Chambers Street, City of New York.<sup>2</sup>

They were listed in the 1880 Federal Census, New York, New York Co., New York City, District 597, p. 14, enumerated 4 June 1880, 167 East 83rd St, Dwelling 82, Family 146 (all b. NY, all their parents b. NY except as noted) -- Wandell, Francis L., 28, Husband, Lawyer; [Wandell], Charlotte M., 19, Wife, Keeping house; [Wandell], Caroline S., 1, Daughter, at home; McSheehan, Annie, 21, Domestic, Single, b. Ireland, her parents b. Ireland.

He bought a summer home at 261 East Saddle River Road, Saddle River, Bergen Co., NJ and had the house moved from the east side of the road to its present location. Around 1913 he retired and built a larger residence, now 255 East Saddle River Road, Saddle River.

In 1917 he presented architectural drawings for a new school building for the Borough of Saddle River. He personally paid for the building, today (1995) known as "the Old Building," which was completed in 1919 and named after him.

In 1682 Johannes Everts Wendell was agent for Maryland to receive the indemnity from the five nations of Indians for the depredations they had committed in that province. He was Justice of the Peace in 1684 and 1685, Ruling Elder of the Dutch Reformed Church in 1685, Commissioner of Indian Affairs from 1684 to 1690. In 1685 he was commissioned Captain of the Albany company, and in 1690 was Mayor of Albany, NY.

In his will, dated 20 Nov 1691, probated 20 Feb 1692, he left 140 beavers to each of his daughters Elsje and Maritje, be-gotten by his first wife, together with moveables to them belonging from their mother's estate. To Abraham he gave his part of the land called "Sarachtoge" [Saratoga?], being the farm lying south of Fish creek. To Johannes his land called "Steenarabia" [later Lansingburgh] and the island called "Whale Island." To Ephraim the land called "Klinkenbergh" and to his wife his dwelling house in Albany.

Thomas Wandell was the founder of the Alsop family through his nephew, Richard Alsop, whom as a boy he brought from England sometime around the year 1665, and adopted for heir to the large farms, and successor to the rights of Thomas Wandell, derived from the Indian Rate of 1656.

Mr. Wandell's public services in Newtown are chiefly to be estimated from his share in thwarting the benevolent theology of witchburning, which about this time began to overshadow the land. The trial of Ralph Hall and his wife for the dangerous crime of witchcraft resulted in the acquittal of the old pair by a jury of which Mr. Wandell was foreman. It was the only trial of the kind ever held in New Amsterdam.

29 Aug 1671 -- Peter Herren [elsewhere Herron], Pltf. v/s Thomas Wandel, deft. The Court ordered and recommended to both Compose their difference Concerning the Sale of a Servt. betwixt themselves before the Next Court day, or otherwise then to be decided by the Court.<sup>1</sup> On 24 Oct 1671 both parties agreed.<sup>2</sup>

Thomas Wandell, Maspeth Kills. "The last will and Testament of Thomas Wandell of Maspeth Kills in the bounds and limits of Newtown upon Long Island; being subject to sudden sickness and knowing the certainty of death." Leaves all estate, except the following legacies, to his wife Audry Wandell, and makes her his sole executrix. I leave to my cousin Richard Alsop, the piece of salt meadow that lieth within his fence, that incompasseth his dwelling house. Also 2 steers and a case of pistols already in his possession. To Richard Alsop's son Thomas 2 heifers. To my grand son Johanes Lowerison's son, 1 heifer. To Theophilus Phillips 1 heifer. To my sister in law Sarah, wife of Humphrey Clay, the value of £10. "This I ye said Thomas Wandell do owne to be my full desire, by setting to my hand and seale this 29 November, 1688." Witnesses, John Sharpe, Theophilus Phillips. Page 102.--Codicil, confirms the above will, and expressing great love and affection for his wife Audry. Dated January 12, 1688. Witnesses, John Lowerie, George Hexton. Proved at Court of Oyer and Terminer in Queen's Co., January 29, 1689. At a Court of Sessions held in Jamaica, February 4, 16 89/90, Mr. Samuel Edsall, President, Matthias Harvey, John Seaman, Nathaniel Denton, John Tredwell, Justices, Mrs. Audry Wandell presenting to ye said Court, an account of the Court of Oyer and Terminer, held in Queens Co., January 29, 1689. She was recommended to apply for Letters of administration to the honored Lieutenant-Governor, Jacob Leisler, Esq. Daniel Denton, Clerk. Jacob Leisler, Lieutenant-Governor, Commander in Chief, etc. To all to whom these presents may come. Know ye that at a Court of Oyer and Terminer in Queens Co. on the 29th day of January last, the will of Thomas Wandell was proved. Letters of administration are granted to his widow, Audry Wandell, April 4, 1690.
